



APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF THE STATUTORY EXEMPTION AGAINST THE PROFESSIONAL DESIGNATION EXAMINATION (“PDE”)

NB: The grant of the statutory exemption against the PDE to qualifying applicants does not in any way supersede the requirement of obtaining the necessary NQF Level 4 or 5 real estate qualification, as the case may be. Principal/non-principal estate agents wishing to apply for the grant of the statutory PDE exemption are required to complete this application form and to email the completed form to exemptions@theppra.org.za. Upon receipt of the application the PPRA will verify the applicant’s record to determine whether the applicant qualifies for the grant of the statutory PDE exemption. Applicants will be advised, in writing, of the outcome of the statutory PDE exemption application as soon as possible thereafter.

NB: To qualify for the grant of the statutory exemption against the Professional Designation Examination (PDE) the applicant must have been issued with valid fidelity fund certificates by the PPRA for a **continuous (without a break) period of five years at any time prior to 15 July 2008**. If there was, for any reason whatsoever, a break in the required continuous five-year period it will not be possible for the PPRA to grant the requested PDE exemption. The nature of the PDE exemption that may be granted to successful applicants depends on the status of the fidelity fund certificates held by applicants during the required continuous five-year period.
