



## **AN UPDATE ON STAKEHOLDER CONSULTATIONS HELD BETWEEN THE PPRA AND THE VARIOUS INDUSTRY REPRESENTATIVE BODIES REGARDING REGULATION 33.2.2 DEALING WITH THE STANDARD OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING FOR PROPERTY PRACTITIONERS**

This serves to provide an update to all PPRA stakeholders on the PPRA stakeholder consultations held with the various industry representative bodies in terms of Regulation 33.2.1 of the Property Practitioners Act. This regulation required the PPRA to consult in good faith with the representative bodies in the various industries in which property practitioners operate, and establish the following:

- qualification standards for property practitioners;
- course Material that will enable persons who wish to qualify as property practitioners to be properly equipped as such and to qualify as property practitioners in accordance with the standards established by the Authority;
- professional designation examinations to be written by persons who wish to qualify as a property practitioner; and
- standards for the practical training of candidate property practitioners

Stakeholder consultations were started in 2022 immediately after the release of the Regulations and several important resolutions were made, making it worthwhile for the PPRA to share the developments and to keep stakeholders updated.
